## Principal's Annual Report 2014-15

Its great pleasure to present 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Report of self financed multi-faculty Shri Ram College, Muzaffarnagar. The first and the largest among the conglomerate of Shri Ram Group's about a dozen vocational higher education colleges, it has recorded sustained growth and intensification of its quality of various operations in its 10<sup>th</sup> year, albeit with all the constraints of a backwash fringe area of the NCR and thus without a level playing-field with regard to national competitiveness. All men and women shouldering its operations, students and society deserve the credit of this growth under the overall patronage of the Groups Chairman.

### **1. Strength of Students**

A total of 3651 (3659 in 2015-16 – 24% Gen., 33% OBC, Minority 24%, SC 19%) students were admitted. In this session, percentage of SC students rose to 15 % from previous year's 11% ; those of General declined by 3% age points, OBC declined by 1% age point and Minority remained constant. Girls' at 26 % remained almost constant. In the current session (2015-16) the trend of rise of SC (19%) continued, Minority % remained constant and decline in General and OBC share continued.

### **2. Admission**

At entry level in UG and PG Programmes, a total of 1725 seats were available, of which 56 % were in the faculty of Business Administration and Commerce and second highest (18%) being in the faculty of Education. As in previous years, comprehensive admissions publicity, counselling and process of admissions was executed with the College policy of encouraging deprived sections, women, minority and poor students.

### **3. Orientation and Induction Programmes**

Like previous year, the beginning of the session was featured by Induction and Orientation programmes for entry level students to make them feel at home with new campus and new programme of study. In Orientation Programmes a few basic concepts to bridge the gap between secondary education and the need of the undergraduate programmes is undertaken. Special English language skill development is taken care with emphasis.

### **4. Students' Council**

About 5 dozen class/section representatives and also the representatives from various interest areas of students as discipline, welfare, hostel, girls etc. formed the general body of the council which in turn formed an Executive Body by consensus or election in case of need. Students' Council coordinated with the Student's Welfare and Scholarship Committees of SRC so that the most of the economically weaker students are benefited by Social Welfare Department of U.P. As a result, a total of Rs. 2.11 crore was received by students of SRC, out of which Rs. 1.25 crore belonged to SC, Rs. 0.65 crore to OBC, Rs. 0.16 crore to Minority and the rest to General category students. Shri Ram Cheritable Trust gifted away Rs. 2.7 lakh to very poor student which increased to Rs. 11.81 lak in





2015-16. An amount upto 11 lacs every year is subsidised in fee concession to students of different classes.

### **5. Results of University Examinations**

Computer Science Department had excellent result with 100% and 23 Ist Divisions in M.Sc. and 98 % result and 96 % Ist Division in BCA. Six UG Departments (Biotech, Microbiology, Fine Arts, Journalism, Teacher Education and Business Administration) has 100% result and I Divisioners rangis from 40% to 100%. Among 5 PG programmes 4 (Computer Science, Biotechnology, Microbiology, Commerce) obtained 100% result and 100% I Divisioners. Pass percentage in Physical Education was 96% and same percentage of I Divisioners.

### **6. University Toppers and Rankers**

In this academic session Gold Medal and III Rank of the University was received by M.Sc. (CS) students of SRC. Another I rank in the University was obtained by BFA. Other University ranks include M.Sc. (CS) III, M.Sc. (Microbiology) V, M.Sc. (Biotech) II and V, M.Com. II, BFA and III, IV, V, BJMC V, BBA IV.

### **7. Training and Placements**

A total of 306 students were placed by 23 Companies that visited SRC in the year. BCA graduates bagged the highest number of placements numbering 113 followed by BBA 87, B.Com. 85, Biotech 10, BFA 7 and BJMC 4. Among prominent Companies having visited the college include Ericsson, Tirupati Structure, Avantha Business Solution, TCS, Wipro, NIIT and so on. In the current year 2015-16 till April 16, 53 placement by 21 Companies have been made and the process is continuing.

### **8. Faculty, Other staff and Their Achievements**

College had a total faculty of 138, presently 147, of whom 45 are Ph.D., 5 M.Phil., 28 Masters with NET and remaining 67 PG. Other staff was 45. Three teachers of Education Department qualified NET. Department of Business Administration produced one Ph.D. and continues supervising 08 Ph.D. theses, wrote 02 books and published 04 research papers. Commerce Department produced 01 book, 03 Monographs and 12 research papers. Department of Computer Application published 02 books, 02 research papers and attended 04 seminars/conferences/workshops. In this session 02 teachers of Computer Application Department won Appreciation Awards of SRGC and 01 of Rotary Club. Quality of faculty members adjudged by a feedback system ranged from 66 to 82 out of 100. Of 147 faculty members 86 % scored 70 or above out of 100. Departments hold discussions on various themes in Saturday Tea Club (about 10 a year) and also hold in house FDP Programmes.

### **9. Research Projects and Grants**

Indian Council of Philosophical Research, New Delhi sanctioned a research grant of Rs. 10 lakh to Dr. Preeti Singh of Education Department. Research Projects continue to be submitted recently also (2 by CA)

### **10. Publications**

Education Department's 04 faculty members published 04 research papers in national (1) and international (3) journals.

### **11. Innovation Centre**

An Innovation Centre for the students of SRGC was inaugurated by the District Magistrate, Muzaffarnagar in the presence of Libby Mc Donald and Dr. Lengseth, both from Messachussets Institute of Technology, USA who were in the Group Colleges to make preliminary preparation for a MIT-SRGC Joint Project on Municipal Waste





Management of Muzaffarnagar Town. Among the 5 Projects being run by interdisciplinary team at the centre one on welding wires by Computer Application Department is in advance stage.

### **12. Academic Activities**

Departments hold academic events for students like Seminars (10); paper presentations (20), guest lectures (8), quiz competitions (22) group discussions (7) debates (9). For teachers Saturday Tea Club meetings (8T) were held and discussions and paper reading were conducted.

### **13. International Relations and Other Collaboration**

An MOV was signed in Aug. 2015 by the Principal of SRGC and IIT Bombay for establishing Super Resource Centre which is being used by different Colleges of the group for learning basic computer skills by students. Collaboration with MIT (USA) was executed over Municipal Water Management of Muzaffarnagar town.

### **14. Extra Curricular Activities**

Learning with entertainment tours were organised. Sixteen such tours were conducted in the session by various departments.

### **15. Extension Service**

Teachers from Education Department have been given awards by Civic Bodies and also by SRGC in recognition of their leading extension activities as for womens empowerment.

### **16. Annual and Other Sports Tournaments**


In Intercollegiate tournaments 174 ; In interuniversity 25 and at national level 3 students played from the college.. 01 student won Bronze in Best Physique at All India level; 02 girls won silver and Bronze in Kick Boxing; 01 boy won Silver in Body Building, 01 boy Silver in Soft Ball at National Games. The trend of acheiving medals even at International (Bronze in Teakwood in China) level and more continued in current session (2015-16). In Inter-collegiate tournaments Gold in Best Physique and Silver in Kick Boxing were won by Shri Ram College students. At Inter-collegiate level there were 03 trophy winners. In Collegiate annual tournament 749 students took part in 08 disciplines; highest being in Cricket (150), Athletics (145), Kho-Kho (128) and Volleyball 95.

### **17. Alumni Meet**

Major Alumni Meet in 2015 was organised in Jan in which 260 Alumni of SRGC assembled in SRC Auditorium and held whole day-long programmes including their introduction and their visit to respective departments, Lunch and formation of the Executive Body of the Alumni Association.

### **17. Awards and Recognitions**

SRGC or its Chairman received 8 national/international recognitions for educational entrepreneurship, quality of SRGC Colleges, campus preparedness educational excellency and global best practices in Education. Prominent among them were 'Campus Preparedness Award' by Campus Management, USA at New Delhi ; 'Econs Education Excellency Award' by Confederation of Education Excellence at New Delhi and '50 most Influential Education Entrepreneurs of the World at World Education Congress at Mumbai.
