MARKET SURVEY OF KOLHUS AND JAGGERY PRODUCTION

Objectives of the study

The study was conducted with some specific objectives.

- 1. To provide information of exact number of kolhus operating in Muzaffarnagar district.
- To study the production capacity (individual and whole) of kolhus producing Sugarcane basedJaggery

Duration of Study

One year (Dec 2015 to November 2016)

Sanctioned Amount of Project

Rs. 50,000/-

Students engaged in project

2 students were involved in research and data collection for the project.

Stipend paid to them = Rs. 10,000/- each

TA/DA was reimbursed whenever they were in field for survey.

Research methodology

- The primary data was collected through survey of different villages in district
 Muzaffarnagar and list of Kolhu operators was prepared.
- Secondly, information was gathered on their annual production of Jaggery and their consumer market.







Data Analysis and Interpretation

A survey was conducted to study jaggery's production and Kolhu's operating in Muzaffarnagar.

The survey was conducted in 200 villages and list was prepared of Kolhu operator with

following data:

- 1. Name of Operator
- 2. Address
- 3. Contact
- 4. Total Production of Jaggery (annually)
- 5. Major consumer

Some major findings are:

- In total, 1500 Kolhu's were found to be in operation in District Muzaffarnagar with their annual production of enormous 23 lakh tons.
- Approximately 78% Kolhu's are well maintained and in reach to Gur Mandi and sell their product directly, rest 22% sell their major jaggery to local vendors and wholesalers.



- It is observed that 93% operators are happy with their sales and 7% customers are unsatisfied with the sale.
- 4. Degradation of Jaggery (Chemical and MicrobialO was major issue related to their sales.

- 5. The value of the product is excellent in 75% cases.
- Operators describes product as one of the finest product to be consumed and especially for health.
- Kolhu operators (approximately 59%) are likely to always sale their product in Mandi,
 24% customers in both Mandi and local vendors, while, rest of them are interested to
 sale only to local vendors/wholesalers.



- Proper packaging and labeling on the product like manufacturing date , expiry date , prices etc. are not mentioned anywhere.
- 9. No proper testing of Jaggery is done according to FSSAI parameters.
