The Vision and Mission of UBA

#### Vision:

To involve professional and other higher educational institutions of the country in the process of indigenous development of self-sufficient and sustainable village clusters in tune with the notion of 'GrāmSwarāj' propounded by Mahatma Gandhi

#### Mission:

In accordance with the above mentioned vision, *Unnat Bharat Abhiyān* will strive to pursue the following:

- Develop the necessary mechanism and proper networking among educational institutions, implementation agencies (PanchāyatiRāj Institutions) and the grass root voluntary organizations to enable effective intervention at the field level.
- Select suitable rural clusters and effectively participate in the holistic development of these clusters using eco-friendly sustainable technologies and local resources creating sufficient employment opportunities in the process, harnessing multifarious Govt. schemes as well as the efforts of voluntary organizations.
- Simultaneously, reorient the ethos, the academic curricula and research programs in
  professional institutions to make these more compatible with the national needs including
  those of rural areas, thus contributing to capacity building towards indigenous

At Sahavli Village Mr. Ankit Kumar, and Mr. Rishabh Bhardwaj along with 25 volunteer students arranged village visit in order to communicate with local people effectively and on these days survey were taken from around 60 households.

- Organic agriculture appropriately integrated with efficient utilization of the animal resource.
- Development and efficient utilization of biofuels and other renewable and locally available sources of energy.
- Proper watershed management and availability of good quality drinking water.
- · Low-cost rural habitat and sanitation
- Facilitating rural artisans, craftsmen and rural entrepreneurs-development of decentralized rural industries with appropriate backup of S&T.
- · Development of the basic amenities and infrastructure etc.

Total 240 students were present there. The selection of students was based on first come first serve. The teacher coordinators of UBA in different departments of SRC received the names of their students who wish to work as UBA volunteer in adopted villages.

The Water management and awareness programme in selected village under UBA banner programme conducted on February 22, 2019 in UBA-SRC adopted village Sahavli. The programme was organized by Department of Biosciences, and the Inaugral program was started with the lamp lighting by Gram Pradhan of Sahavli Shri Ashok Kumar. The welcome speech was given by UBA-SRC convenor Dr. Ashwani Kumar. Total 60 students were present there. Who visited the village, meet with villagers and make them aware about management of natural resources.

The Water Management program works with communities to harvest and store rainwater for direct use, and/or replenish groundwater by building and restoring infrastructure in villages. It supports revival of traditional water bodies, construction of water storage infrastructure, and safe disposal of wastewater. It promotes safe drinking water for all with innovative low-cost, sustainable technologies and behaviour. It creates awareness about the need for water conservation and builds capacities of local communities for better management and long-term sustainability of their water resources. The program seeks opportunities to collaborate for continuous improvement and replication of low-cost water management interventions.

India has about 18 percent of the world's population and only 4 percent of the world's water resources. It is severely water-stressed, thereby making water management a national priority. India uses about 230 cubic kilometres of groundwater annually, which is more than a quarter of the global total, making it the world's largest user of groundwater. About 90 percent of the groundwater extracted is used for irrigation and over 60 percent of the irrigated land in India is supported primarily by groundwater supplies. For an agrarian country like India, water is a key driving force of agriculture and has a direct bearing on its productivityl and sustainability. However, unregulated extraction and non-replenishment has reduced groundwater drastically and deteriorated its quality. The crisis has worsened further due to climate change, which causes erratic and intense rainfall. This, coupled with lack of sufficient runoff storage capacity, leads to the loss of precious freshwater into the sea. Furthermore, there is a serious lack of infrastructure for safe disposal of wastewater in villages, which further leads to contamination of water resources. Water contamination is a serious problem, giving rise to health and hygiene concerns.






Fig. 2 APL/BPL DATA




Fig 3 .CASTE DATA




Fig.4 FAMILY MEMBERS DATA


The survey conducted for number of family members concluded that approximately 55% households having 3-4 members, while there are 45 % of family which have more than four members.




#### Fig. 5 -MIGRATION DATA




Fig.7 TYPE OF HOUSE




Fig. 8 TYPES OF TOILET DATA






Fig. 14 Cooking DATA




Fig. 16 LAND HOLDING DATA





Fig 18 AG. PRODUCE DATA




Fig 20 VILLAGE PROBLEMS DATA
