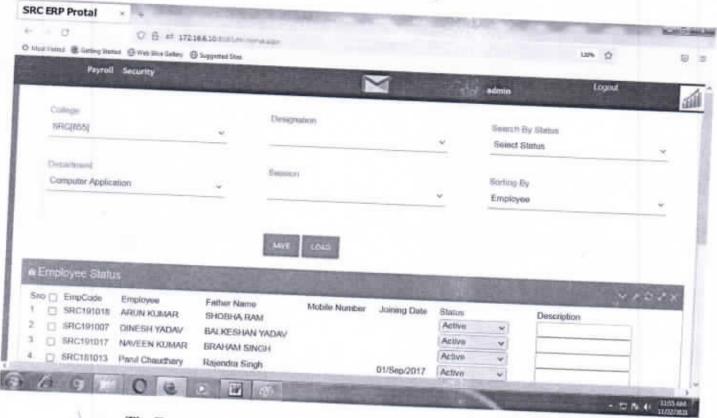

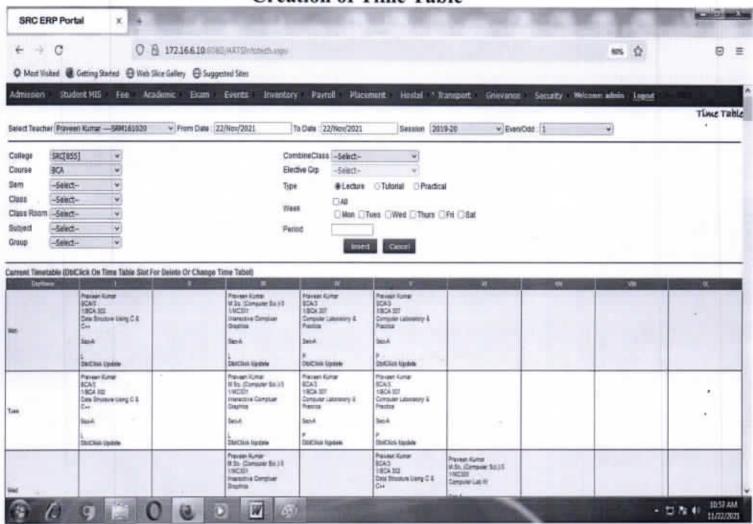

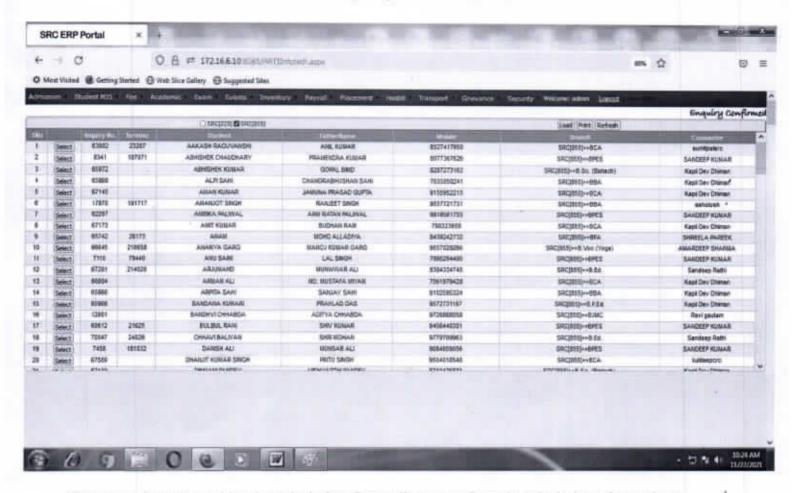

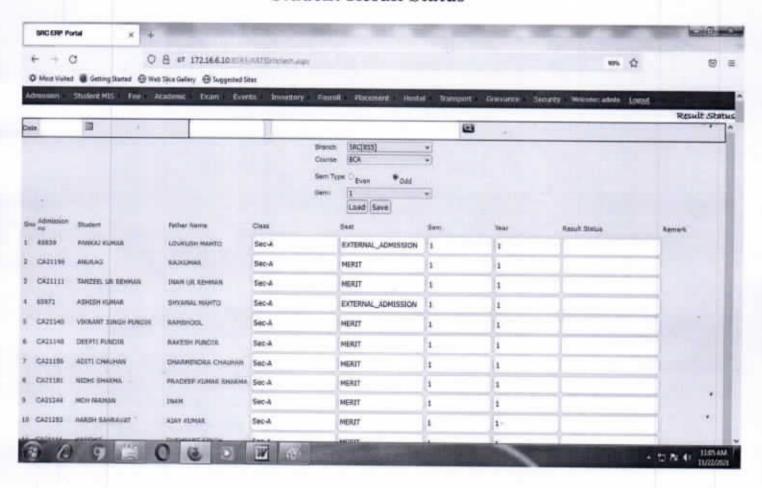

E-Governance Policy

Objective of E-Governance Policy:

- 1. Implementation of E-governance in various functioning of the institution
- 2. Achieving efficiency in our functioning
- 3. Promoting transparency and accountability
- 4. Achieving paperless administration of the institution
- 5. Providing easy access to information
- Making the institution visible globally

Policy:

- In order to provide simpler and efficient system of governance within the institution, it is decided to adopt and implement e-governance in maximum activities of our functioning.
- The institution has already started with e-governance in some aspects of functioning like administration, admissions, student support, library, Finance & Accounts, etc.

E-governance in following areas: For convenience purposes, the policy is divided into various areas of operation. These areas of operation are illustrative and the society reserves the right to implement e-governance even in the areas not enlisted herewith.

- Website: The website should act as a mirror of the college activities and information about all activities, important notices, etc should be made easily available to the outsiders. For this purpose, a separate development cell has been constituted consisting of Faculty members and students. Along with it, training is provided to the existing staff to undertake the responsibility of website administration and updation at the college level.
- 2. Student Admission and Support: The College has decided to process all admissions in online mode. This will cover admissions to all courses whether graduate or post graduate. For this purpose, a college management software/erp has been installed to automate the activity of admission enquiry, admission confirmation, fee submission and managing student MIS. An independent admission team under the headship of Admission Controller has been constituted for the implementation of this aspect of the policy. Also facility for Grievance Redressal has been provident to students in their logins to launch any grievance to the college authorities.

- 3. Finance & Accounts: For ease of maintaining accounts, the society is already using Tally software. Also college ERP provides the facility to submit fees and provide necessary fee slips to the students. Fee structure and various concessions may be applied using the software. Students may also check fee status and balances through their logins.
- 4. Library: We have the privilege of having one of the best library in the area. To continue with this legacy, we need to add more and more e-learning resources for the benefit of the teachers and students. Library is presently using library module provided in the college ERP. It is updated regularly as per the needs. Also the OPAC system should be converted into a web based service for others to utilize the library resources effectively. Similarly newer e-learning resources like journals, etc are subscribed taking into account the recommendations of the library advisory committee through DELNET. Recommendations of the teachers and students are also taken into account while subscribing to these resources. Appropriate training to the staff and the students for using the e-learning resources is provided.
- Administration: Maximum of the administration of the society is handled with ICT based technology. Facility is provided for online leave management of employees, internal communication between the employees, Academic administration etc. Students also obtains maximum services like transfer certificates, bonafide certificates, etc. in online mode.
- 6. Examination: Uploading attendance, sessional marks, etc. is done in online manner. Faculty members may upload the attendance, assignments marks and internal assessment marks through the examination module present in the college ERP. Student may view his performance in various assessments through his login. Utmost secrecy and confidentiality need to be maintained while handling examinations and work needs to be done utmost care and caution. College Examination Incharge supervises the entire process of examination under the guidance of the Principal of the college.
- CCTV: Excellent modernise coverage of college campus that includes places like corridors
 and canteens which helps the administration to monitor all discipline issues at the
 maximum level.
