### FDP on NAAC Awareness

#### Objective:

- To educate and train faculties of colleges about NAAC new guideline.
- To upgrade about various Criteria and new metrics formal by NAAC.
- To share best practices that can be used for institutional development.
- To interact with various experts and resolve the problems facing during NAAC

**Time :** 01: 00 pm to 04:00 pm

**Duration :** 02/01/2020 to 16/01/2020

Keeping in mind the above objectives, a two weeks in-house faculty development workshop on "NAAC" for developing Self-Study Report (SSR) was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in the College Seminar Hall. IQAC Coordinator Dr. Vinit Kumar Sharma and some other senior faculties from SRGC Institutions facilitated the workshop as Resource Persons. Dr. Alok Gupta, Ms. Sakshi Shrivastav, Dr. Prerna Mittal, Dr Pankaj Sharma, Er. Rohitash Singh, Er Pawan Kumar Goel facilitating the sessions updated the members about major revisions made in the Revised Accreditation Framework. The members were also familiarized with the processes involved in the A&A viz., procedure pertaining to IIQA, pre-qualifier, online submission of Self-Study Report (SSR), Data Validation and Verification (DVV) Process, initiation of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS), compliance to DVV clarifications, on-site Peer Team Visit (PTV).

Further, during two-day long deliberations, each of the seven criteria was discussed at length taking into consideration the Quantitative (QnM) and Qualitative Metrics (QIM). Each of the metric across all the Key Indicators (KIs) were discussed with appropriate supporting documents to be uploaded. Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), Essential Metrics and Opt-out Metrics were also discussed.

On the whole, the two weeks deliberations enabled the members to seek more clarity on the processes and procedures involved in the NAAC A & A. Criterion-wise discussion and interaction

facilitated the members to become more self-reliant and thereby work effectively in developing the Self-Study Report. All the Heads and members participated and benefited from the informative session.

Day 1 (02/01/2020): Principal Dr. Aditya Gautam in his opening address said – “As we gear-up to prepare ourselves for the upcoming second cycle of NAAC accreditation process, this workshop shall strive to throw light on our preparedness for the same. Further, I hope that the deliberations will certainly make all the members abreast of the revised accreditation framework of NAAC and shall draw a roadmap in collecting relevant inputs for each criterion; thereby will enable us to effectively prepare the Self-Study Report (SSR).

Dr. Vinit Kumar Sharma, IQAC Coordinator discussed the importance of the program and shared the outlines of filling SSR and documentation preparation.

Day 2(03/01/2020): Ms. Sakshi Shrivastav, Dean SRCE discussed the criteria 1- Curricular Aspects

Day 3(04/01/2020): Dr Vivek Kumar Tyagi, Deptt of Business administration, discussed the remaining concepts of criteria 1- Curricular Aspects with the Ms. Sakshi Shrivastav

Day 4(05/01/2020): Er Pawan Kumar Goel discussed the concepts of criteria 2 Criterion 2- Teaching Learning and Evaluation

Day 5(06/01/2020): Er. Rohitash Singh, discussed the remaining concepts of criteria 2 and solves the query from audience

Day 6 and Day 7 (07/01/2020 and 08/01/2020): Dr Sourabh Jain, HoD Bio Science discussed the Criterion 3- Research, Innovation and Extension

Day 8(09/01/2020):

On the eighth day Dr. Perna Mittal, Vice Principal of Shri Ram College, discussed the Criterion 4. While presenting a power point presentation, She said that in order to raise the level of education from high to high, the government has directed the colleges to conduct National Assessment and Accreditation Council (CHC). She said that the institution is evaluated by NAAC on the basis of many important points like availability of educational resources available in the colleges as well as employment opportunities and other non-teaching facilities being provided by the colleges. The level of educational institution is assessed on the basis of grades awarded by NAAC, due to which it is necessary to conduct NAAC by government, aided and private educational institutions affiliated to various universities.



Day 9 (10/01/2020):

on the ninth day, Dean Computer Applications Dr Nishant Rathi discussed "Student Support and Progression" and presented a detailed power point presentation. He said that while the objective of NAAC is to raise the standard of education on one hand, on the other hand the skill of the students. To evaluate the support given to the institute of old students by making them all round. He further said that quality education plays an important role in the development of any country.

Day 10 and 11(11/01/2020 and 12/01/2020):

On the tenth day of the ongoing 15-day Faculty Development Workshop, Dr. Ashfaq Ali, Department of Management, spoke on "Teaching learning and assessment". Dr. Pragati Saxena, Dean Management Studies, Hirank Business School, Noida was present as the chief guest on that day program.

On 11<sup>th</sup> day, Presenting a power point presentation , Dr. Ashfaq Ali said that the purpose of assessment and evaluation of the teacher organization is to measure the expression, ability, feeling, etc. of the teachers of the institution. Assessment is a brief process and evaluation is a comprehensive process. Evaluation is the gathering, analysis and interpretation of information related to the subject in any educational program for any pros and cons. Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation should include the extent to which the set educational objectives are being achieved, how effective the learning experiences provided in the classroom have been, how well the process of behavior change is being accomplished, etc. He further said that in every institution there are two types of students one is fast learner and other is slow learner. In such a situation, educational institutions should establish coordination between both types of students and should keep this fact in mind while giving lectures.

Day 12(13/01/2020):

In the workshop, Dr. SC Kulshrestha, Chairman, Shri Ram Group of Colleges said that at present no field is untouched by competition, be it the field of education. In such a situation, it is the responsibility of the educational institutions to make continuous efforts to increase their technical knowledge by providing high quality educational facilities to their students, so that students can get employment by bringing technical knowledge into practicality along with bookish knowledge. . Efforts are also being made continuously from the government level so that the students can get high quality education. To fulfill this objective, NAAC evaluation has been made mandatory from the government level.

Day 13(14/01/2020):

Dr Pankaj Kumar, Head of Management Department, discussed about Criterion 6- Governance, Leadership and Management. Dr. Pragati Saxena, Dean Management Studies, Hiranak Business School, Noida was present as the chief guest in today's program. Chief guest Dr. Pragati Saxena said that leadership is required for every group. Be it political or social, religious or industrial. Educational organizations are no exception to this. Any group is non-existent without leadership. The officers should be in touch with the employees, treating them as a unit. By these mutual differences, hatred, animosity etc. can be reduced. The officers should hold seminars with the employees and understand each other through mutual consultation and solve the problem through agreement. Only then any organization or organization can achieve its goals. Keeping this in view, NAAC has also included this point in its evaluation

Presenting a power point presentation, Dr. Pankaj Sharma said that the achievement of the goals and objectives of any organization depends on the functioning of its board of directors. Leadership has a special place in the management world, leadership is largely responsible for the success of an organization. In the absence of efficient leadership, no organization can cross the ladder of success. Any organization can be successful only when its management has properly discharged the leadership role. Supervision, management and governance are very important for the success of the organization. The manager gets the employees working under him to do the work according to his instructions. As the manager behaves, as are his ideals, the employees also determine the same behavior. Therefore, as the leadership of the manager will be, the employees will also act accordingly.

Day 14(15/01/2020):

Dr Alok Gupta, Director SRCE discussed in detail regarding Criterion 7- Innovations and Best Practices. Presenting a power point presentation on the occasion, Dr. Alok Gupta said that the success of any organization depends on its value-based work. To achieve its goals, the organization should prepare a visionary approach and work on it. From the point of view of NAAC assessment, gender equality in institutional values, alternative energy, waste management, water harvesting, cleanliness and greenery of the campus, pollution free campus, facilities to be provided to the differently-abled, transport facility, handbook of students/teachers etc. have been included. He further said that the teacher should give equal attention to all the students studying in the class, whether they are fast learners or slow students. It is essential to have good co-ordination between the teacher and the students so that the students can reach their problems to their teachers without any hesitation. These procedures are of paramount importance from the point of view of developing students' understanding of knowledge, classroom management, effective student-teacher communication and quality of instruction, structured teaching and activities that emphasize



learning. For this, regular attendance of students and teachers in the class room is necessary. Outcomes of the learning process in terms of teaching and learning clearly need special attention to the possible learning outcomes for each class and each subject so that it is easily understood by the teachers, school heads.

IQAC Coordinator Dr Vinit Sharma gave an account of our status of preparation for the upcoming A & A process and expressed her concern towards the need for timely gearing-up for the same. The sessions strived to achieve the core value of inculcating quest for excellence amongst the participating staff members.

Day 15(16/01/2020):

It was query solving session and experts solved the queries.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. SC Kulshrestha, Chairman, Shri Ram Group of Colleges said that the country has the widest and most diverse education system in the world. The expansion of privatization and introduction of various courses in new emerging directions have widened the reach of higher education. In such a situation, the seriousness of the government towards the quality of higher education can be understood in such a way that all the educational institutions of the country have been instructed by the government to get NAAC done. NAAC assigns grades on the basis of many important points related to the educational resources available in the colleges, library, laboratory, sports activities etc. as well as other non-teaching facilities.
