Department of Basic Science, Shri Ram College, Muzaffarnagar organized Constitutional Day on 26\11\2018. Program was inaugurated with the lighting of the lamp by the Chief Guest Dr. R.S.Chauhan, Principal, Shri Ram College and Dr. Aditya Gautam. Dr.R.S.Chauhan delivering a speech on the occasion, said that The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act or Right to Education Act (RTE) is an Act of the Parliament of India enacted on 4 August 2009, which describes the modalities of the importance of free and compulsory education for children between the age of 6 to 14 years in India under Article 21A of the Indian Constitution. Dr. Aditya Gautam share their thoughts and said that the RTE Act provides the right of children to free and compulsory education till completion of elementary education in a neighborhood school. It clarifies that 'compulsory education' means obligation of the appropriate government to provide free elementary education and ensure compulsory admission, attendance and completion of elementary education to every child in the six to fourteen age group. 'Free' means that no child shall be liable to pay any kind of fee or charges or expenses which may prevent him or her from pursuing and completing elementary education. In his brief address Prof. Dr. Aditya Gautam said that the duties and responsibilities of appropriate Governments, local authority and parents in providing free and compulsory education, and sharing of financial and other responsibilities between the Central and State Governments.

Some Faculty and Students delivered talk on national anthem and said that the quality of education provided by the government school system is not good. While it remains the largest provider of elementary education in the country, forming 80% of all recognized schools, it suffers from shortage of teachers and infrastructural gaps. Several habitations lack schools altogether. There are also frequent allegations of government schools being riddled with absenteeism and mismanagement and of appointments made on political convenience. Despite the allure of free lunch in the government schools, many parents send their children to private schools. Average school teacher salaries in private rural schools (about Rs.

7,000 per month) are considerably lower than those in government schools.

In the end of session Dr. Vineet Sharma briefed students about the Act provides for admission of children without any certification. However, several states have continued pre-existing procedures insisting that children produce income and caste certificates, BPL cards and birth certificates. Orphan children are often unable to produce such documents, even though they are willing to do so. As a result, schools are not admitting them, as they require the documents as a condition to admission.
