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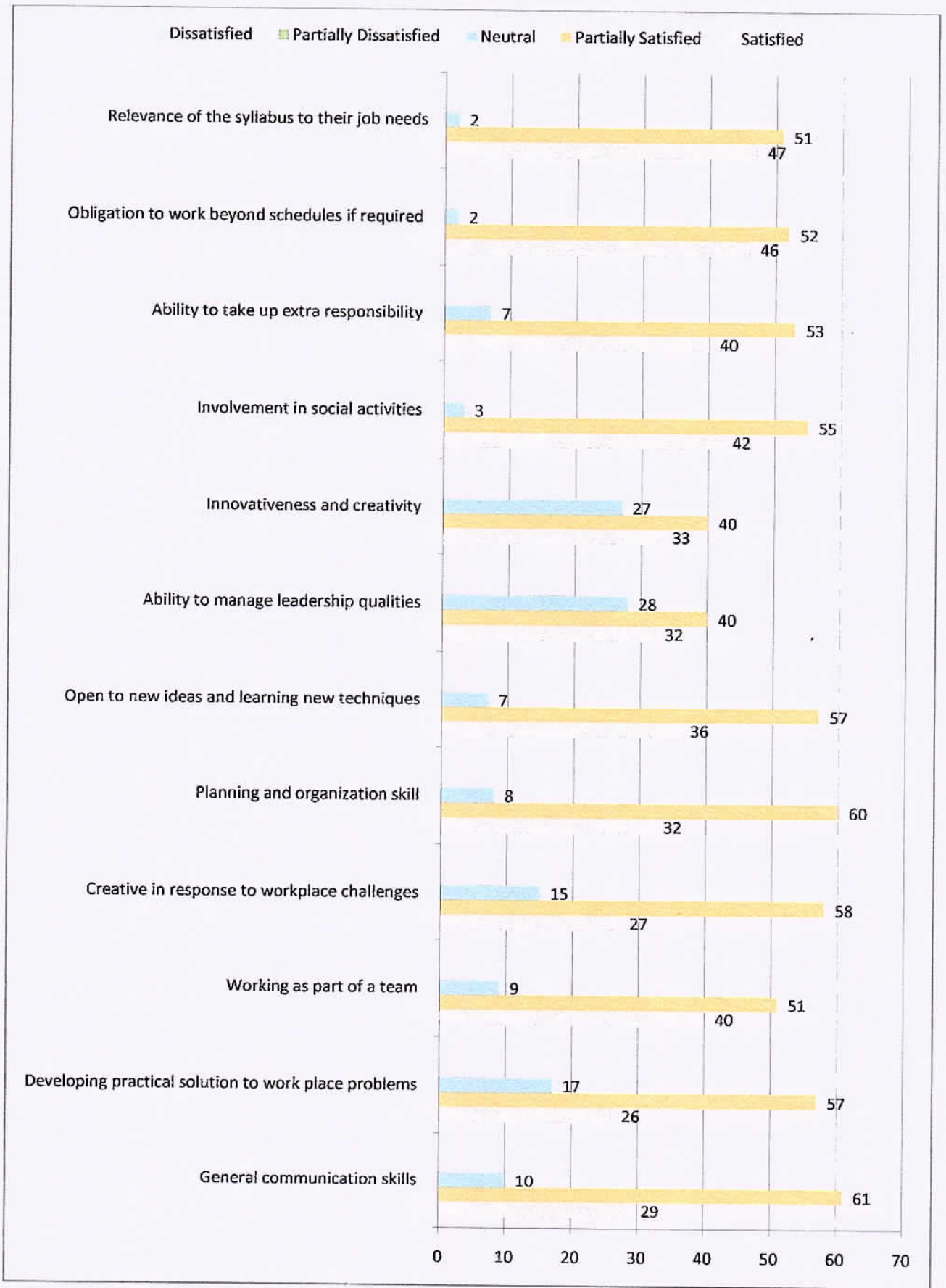
Employers' Feedback

The feedback form consists of 12 items covering various aspects of students' personalities and syllabi of the course. The opinion is given through 5-point Likert scale where the scale is divided into five points from 5 to 1. (*5 denotes satisfied, 4 denotes partially satisfied, 3 denotes neutral, 2 denotes partially dissatisfied and 1 denotes dissatisfied*)

In the year 2019-20 the employers were asked to give their opinion on 12 different aspects assigning each item a score from 5 to 1. After analyzing the entire feedback received from the employers' average scores were calculated.

Following bar chart presents a summary of feedback for each item from the employers and the average scores are given in the next table and pie chart.









It can be observed from the above table that the employers have given the highest score of 4.44 to “Obligation to work beyond schedules” and “Relevance of the syllabus to their job needs” followed by 4.38 to “Involvement in social activities” and “Ability to take up extra responsibility”, whereas as a lowest score of 4.18 to “Developing practical solution to work place problems” and then 4.22 to “Ability to manage leadership qualities” and “Innovativeness and creativity” that means, in the opinion of employers, college is doing well in those areas where rank is high and college has to make more efforts for the areas where the score is low. The average score is 4.31 as an overall performance of the students of Shri Ram College. 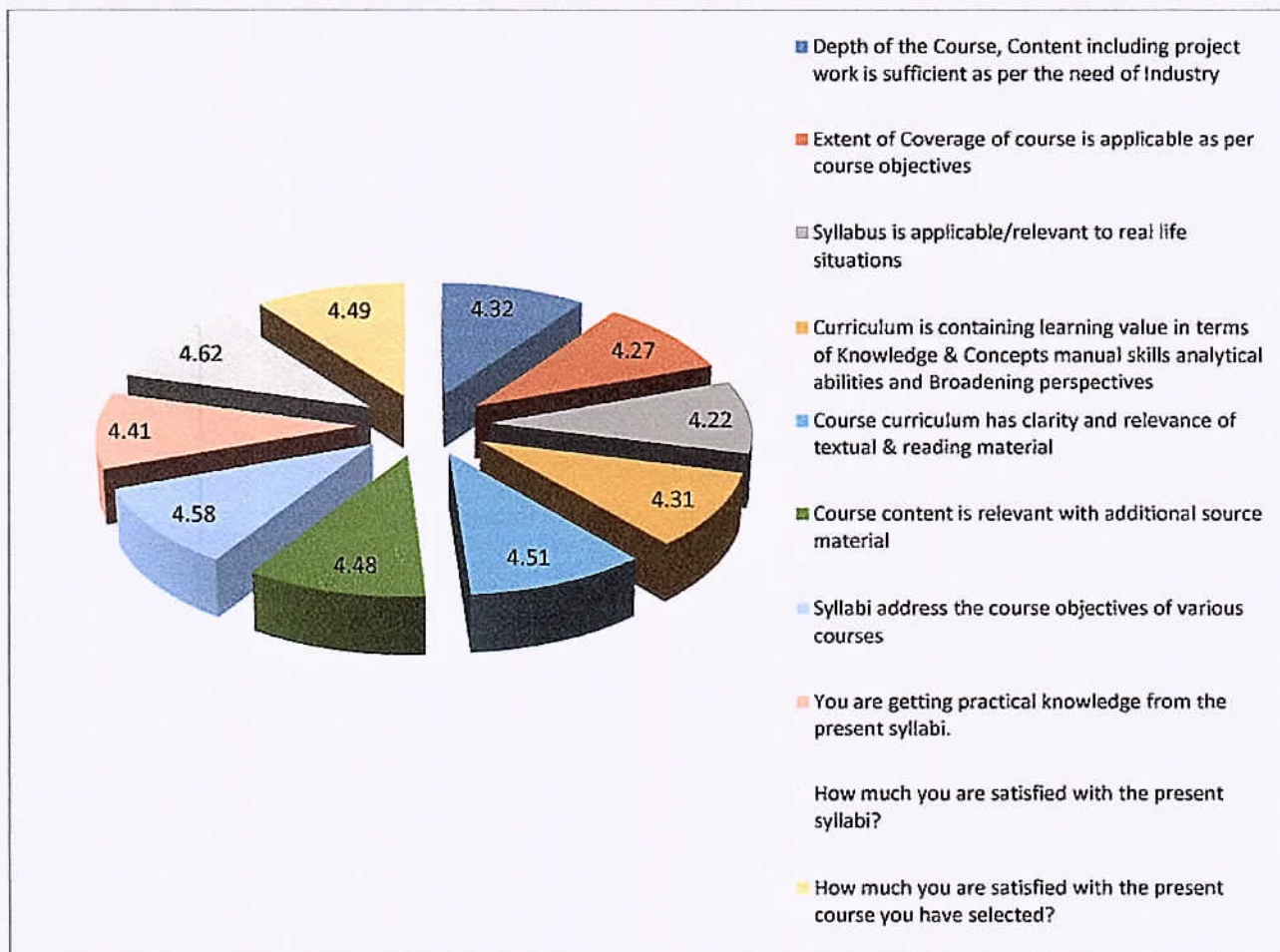



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Alumni Feedback



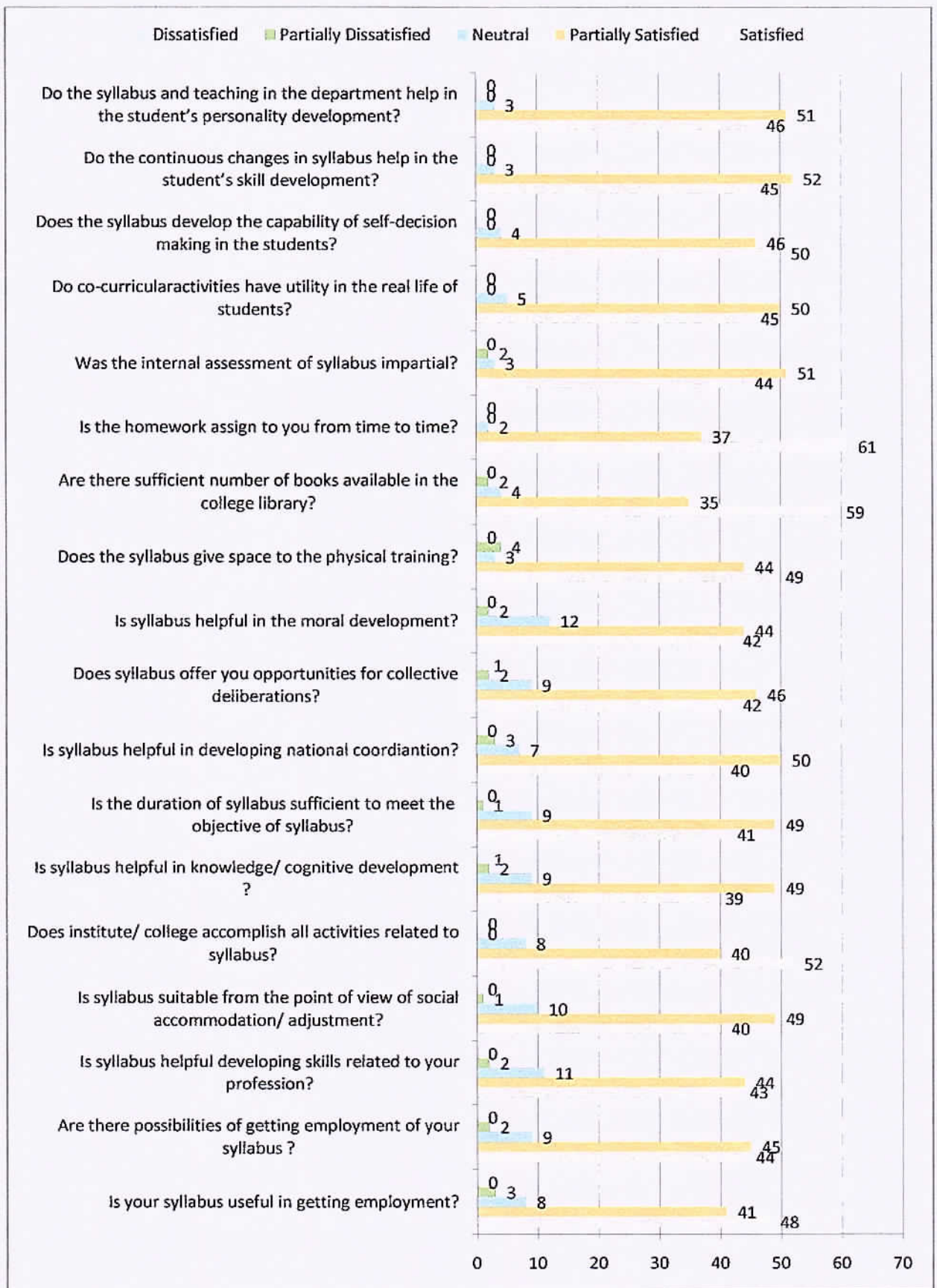

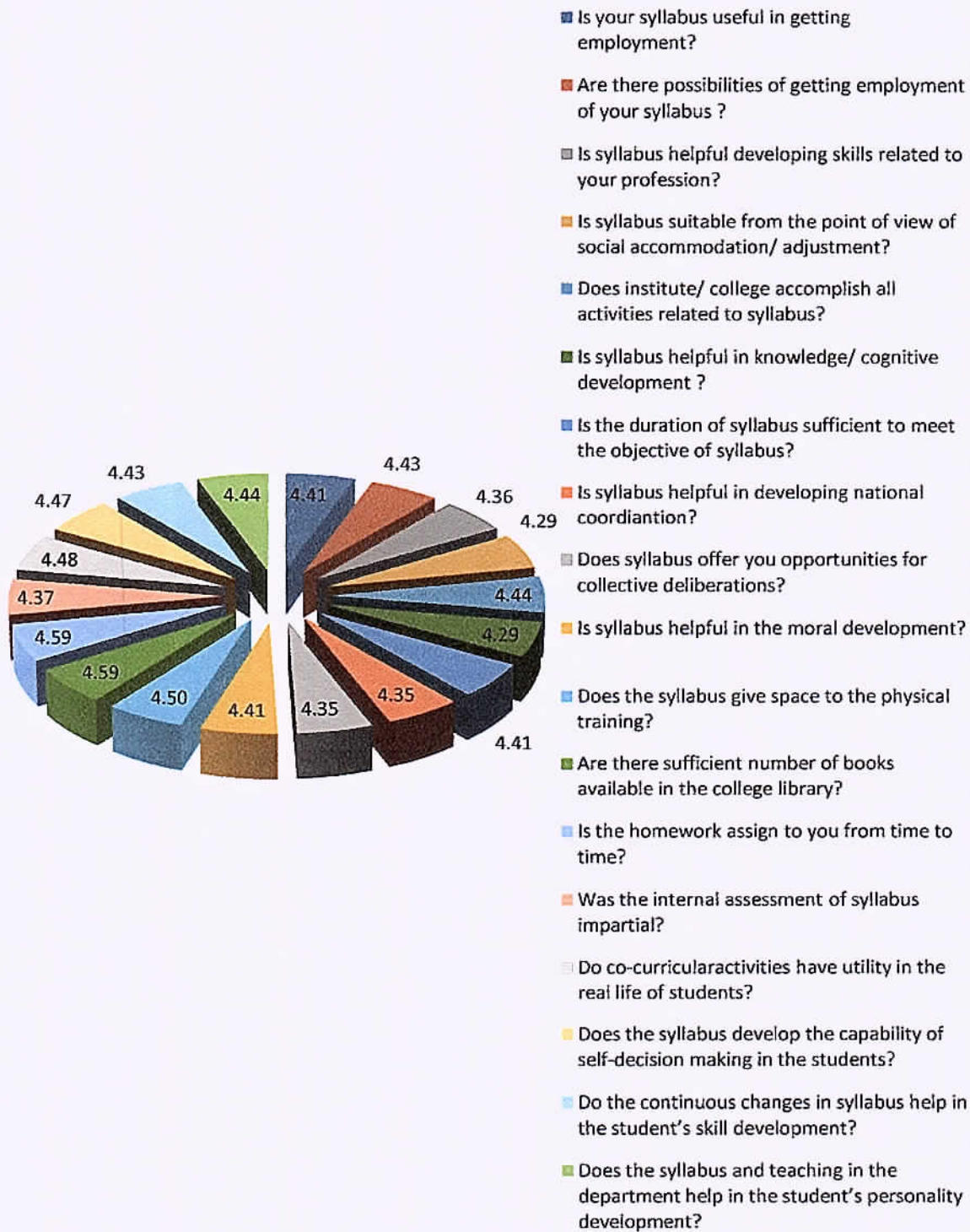

Parents/ Guardian Feedback

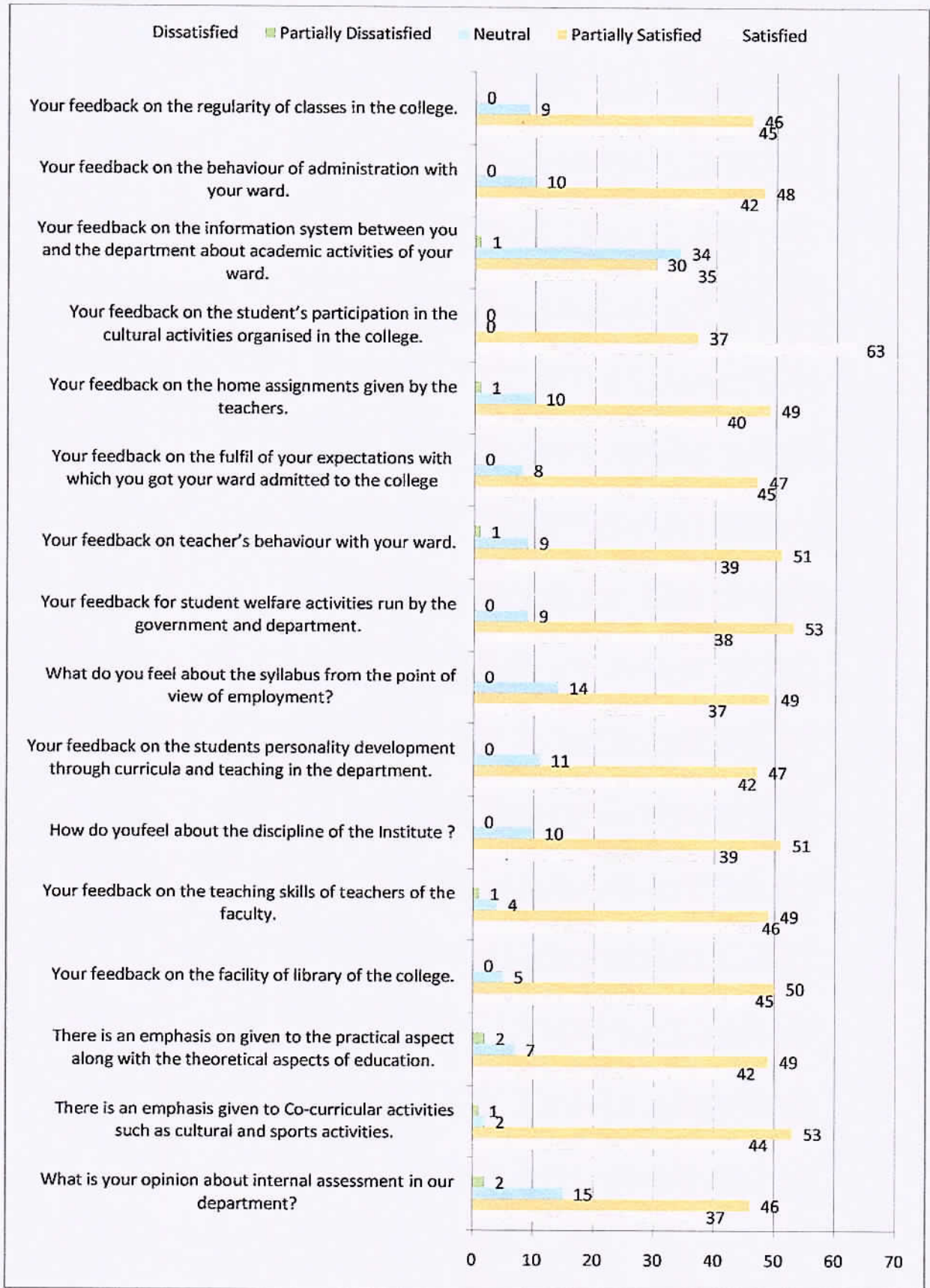

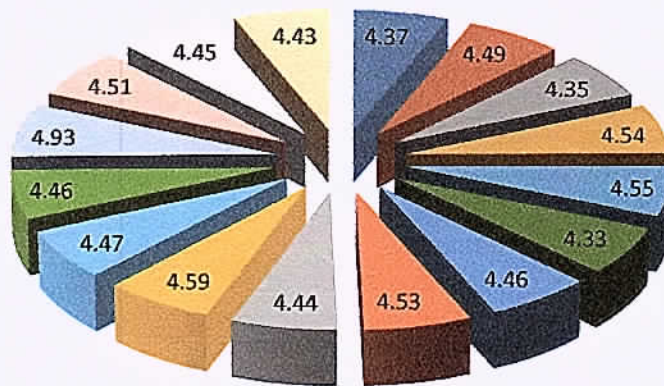

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Faculty Feedback

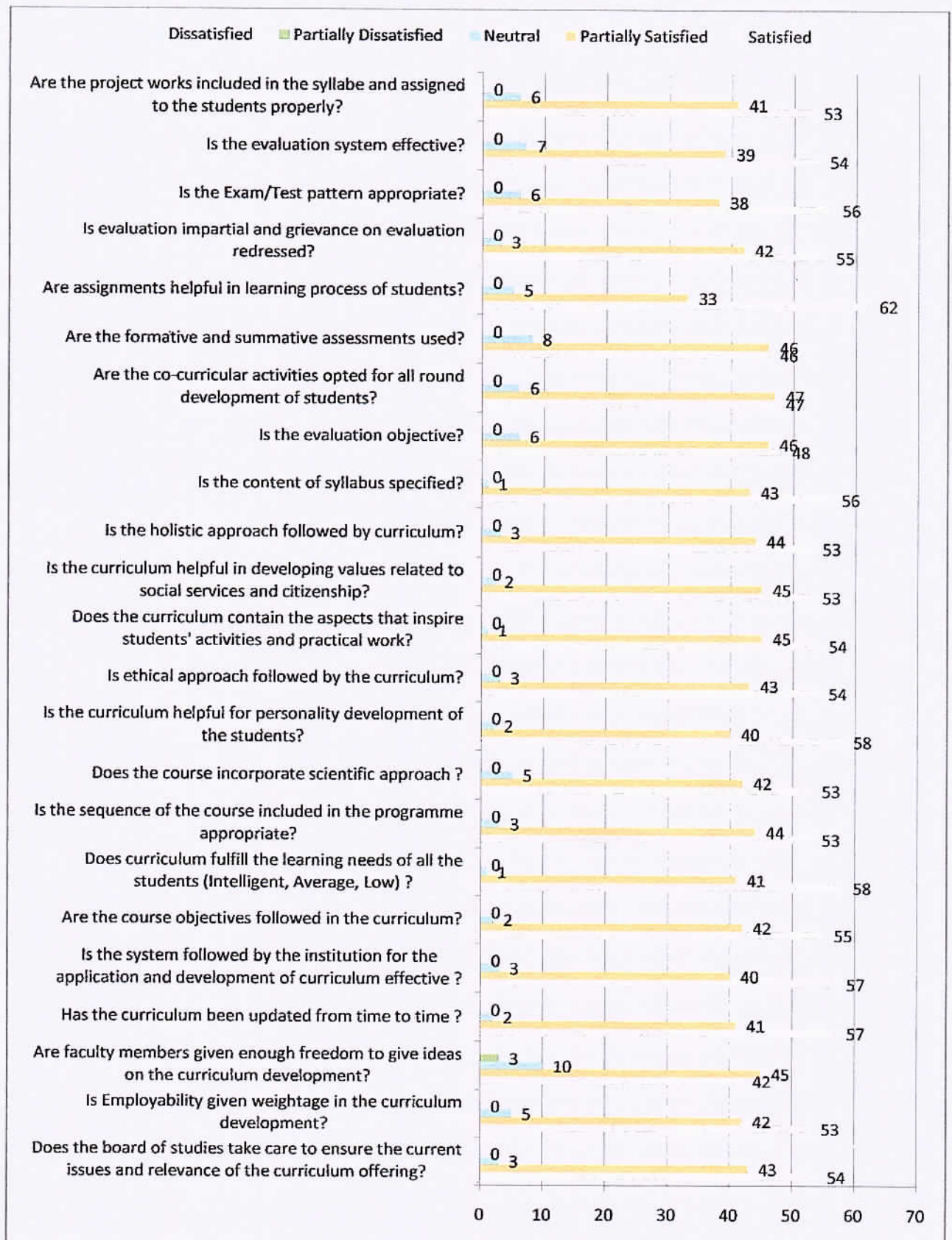

Following bar chart presents a summary of feedback for each item from the faculty and the average scores are given in the next table and pie chart.

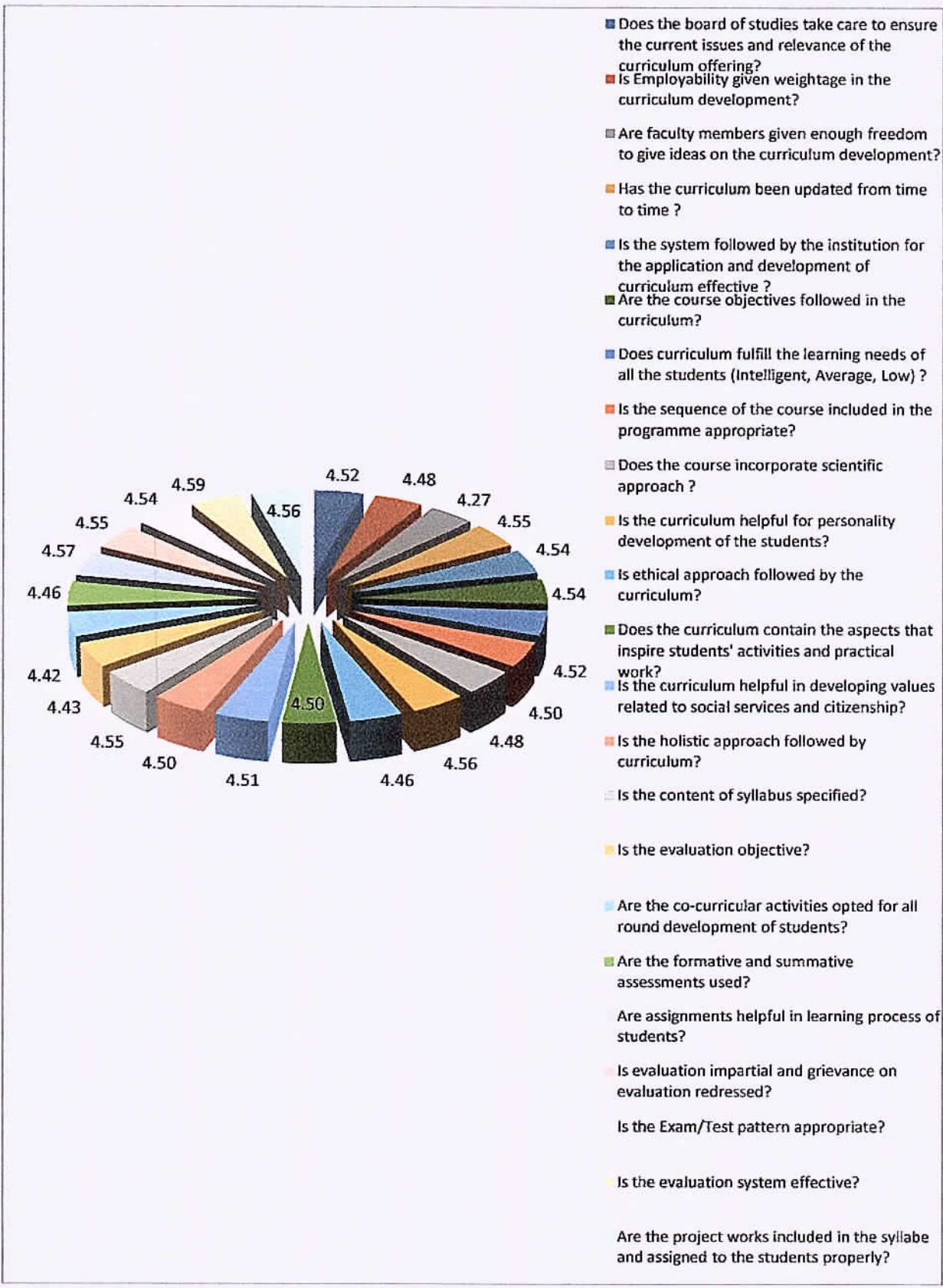


