

# SHRI RAM COLLEGE, MUZAFFARNAGAR, (UP)

## **Principal's Annual Report**

#### Session-2022-23

We are pleased in presenting the annual report of Shri Ram College, Muzaffarnagar, documenting its development and the achievement for the year 2022-23. Shri Ram College is the first and the largest college of Shri Ram Group of Colleges. In session 2022-23, college has conducted many events and successful stories. This can be attributed to the dedication, motivation and team spirit of the faculties, staff, students and members of the management. Shri Ram College, Muzaffarnagar was established in the year 2004 as a selffinanced, multi-faculty affiliated college. Apart from some challenges due to being situated in a comparatively backward border area of the NCR and thus without a level playing-field with regard to national competitiveness, the college jump from earlier NAAC accreditation grade "A" to grade 'A++' on 07-06-2022. All the members (Authority, faculty, staff and students) responsible for its operations. Students and the community deserve all the credit of this achievement under the overall leadership and patronage of Dr. S.C. Kulshrestha, the Chairman of Shri Ram Group of Colleges. Shri Ram College was permanently affiliated to Maa Shakumbhari University, Saharanpur. Our College is one of the largest affiliated college of Maa Shakumbhari University, Saharanpur in reference of number of programmes and number of students. Shri Ram College offered total twenty-four programmes in the session 2022-23, out of which, fifteen are UG and nine are PG programmes. The College has been progressing at a remarkable pace with sustainable growth and spiraling enhancement in quality of education and other operations till the session 2022-23.



The following is the brief report on the major activities performed in Shri Ram College in the session 2022-23

## 1. Strength of Students

Total number of students studied in the session 2022-23 was 5632, out of which 5155 were studied in the UG programmes and 477 were in the PG programmes. Total 1490 seats were earmarked for reserved categories as per the rules of GoI/State Government where total 1473 students were enrolled from these categories, which constitute 98.86% of the total sanctioned earmarked seats. In the present sessions 2022-23, percentage of enrolled SC/ST students to the total enrolled strength was 7.48 % and percentage of enrolled OBC students to the total admitted strength was 39.80 % of total enrolled students in 1st year. Total 998 girl students were admitted in 1st year out of 2794 students during the session, it shows that more than 35% of girl candidates were admitted this year in the college.

In this session 2022-23, 1932 girls and 3700 boys are studying in the college so more than 35% girls' students are studying in the college.

#### 2. Admissions

The College takes the admissions on its first priority, in the present session 2022-23 an extensive admissions campaign through publicity and counseling was conducted. In accordance with the College policy of encouraging the students from comparatively deprived sections of society and providing better opportunity for female, minority and poor students through Talent Search Expedition (TSE). TSE was conducted offline and online mode in this year. At the entry level total 2980 intake was available in 15 UG and 09 PG Programmes where 2794 students admitted in the first year of all UG & PG programmes.

#### 3. Orientation and Induction Programmes

As per policy of the College, individual Department prepares detailed Orientation and Induction programmes in consultation with Principal of the College, IQAC, Coordinator, Dean Academic and senior faculty members. In this session too, Orientation Programmes were organized in all departments in the beginning of the session for the first-year students to make them feel comfortable at new campus and new programme of study. In these Orientation Programmes, rules of the college were discussed with the students. Sessions of personality development/communication skills and English language/common subjects such as mathematical practice was delivered for bridging the gap between their courses of study of their selected UG and PG programmes. Sessions on library, laboratories and hostel rules & regulations and code of conduct were also conducted.

## 4. Students' Participation in College Administration

Students' participation in college operation, wherever desirable is encouraged as the policy of Shri Ram College. In this session also, the students' participation was ensured on priority in terms of representation and membership of various committees. The students were got engaged in the IQAC, Discipline Committee, Students' Welfare Committee, Hostel Committee, Scholarship Committee, Cultural Committee and many more

committees in which participation of student is required. Students' representatives were nominated by the head of department after screening the choices for various committees and students actively participated and do happily their assigned duties.

#### 5. Student' Support services

College provides various student support services such as Personalized Academic Advising, Mentorship Programs, Student Learning Center/Peer-Tutoring, Student Employment Services, Academic Support, Accommodation Services, Student Clubs, Financial Assistance and Student Counseling Services. As a result of students support services, 936 students got fee concession for different classes from Shri Ram College worth Rs. 3483130. 910 economically weaker students were benefited worth Rs. 16049856 through Post metric Scholarship Scheme of Social Welfare/Minority/ Other Backward Department of Uttar Pradesh Government. As a result, 1846 students got financially benefited.

## 6. University Examinations and Results

Among twenty three programmes, Shri Ram College achieved 100% result in eight programmes B.Sc (Biotechnology), B.Ed., B.P.Ed, M.Sc. (Microbiology), M.Sc. (Biotechnology), M.P.Ed. and M.Ed. The pass percentage in five programmes was 95% and above. Result of remaining 8 programs was also good. Total 1256 students passed out of 1428 in final year; hence result of final year students of the college were 87.96%.

## 7. University Toppers and Rankers

In this academic session Shri Ram College recorded marvelous achievement as number of students secured many medals and positions in the University merit list. Students secured 08 Gold Medals, 09 Silver Medals, 06 Bronze Medals and 34 other ranks whose details are as follows:

#### 7. Training and Placements

Training and placement Cell conducted 09 training programmes for competitions, 4 career counseling & Mock Interview Sessions. Coaching was also given for competitive examinations such as, Civil Services, Preparation of Technical aptitude test, Numeric Arithmetic Method Classes for competitive exam, UPJEE B.Ed. entrance, TET, NET, CUET, Preparation of Physical Fitness Test (for those students who want to take admission in M.P.Ed. & B.P.Ed. Courses) for University Level entrance examination is also conducted by the college.

T&P Cell also conducted number of placement activities on-campus and off-campus. 494 students placed in more than 33 companies during various campus drives through on-campus and off-campus.

#### 8. Faculty, Other staff and Their Achievements

In the College, a total of 203 regular faculty members worked during the year as full-time faculty, 09 faculty worked on temporary basis and out of these 70 were holding. Ph.D. degree. Five faculty worked as a Guest faculty. Departments held discussions on various themes in Saturday Club activity. 14 FDPs, 1 PDPs, 1 Short Term course, 1 induction Program and many training sessions were organized in the college for the holistic development of faculty members as well as non-teaching staff. Appreciation awards were received by some faculty members for excellent work in community and extension activities. The faculty members also worked as resource person/ Guest Lecturer in various colleges or organizations and have membership in many academic bodies.

## 9. Research Projects and Grants

A grant of Rs.1329400/-was sanctioned from eleven local industries/institutions/farms for 15 project/ consultancy work of our teachers and students for ten departments. Rs. 1,67,500 worth grant also received from Shri Ram Charitable Trust (SRCT) for Conducting activities for Water Harvesting, Design Development and performance evaluation of natural

yr madarar Yr/ Refrigerator for food commodities and SRC Bio-Pesticides. College management regularly support faculty members for research work.

#### 10. Publications

College published two issues of journal "Prabhandan Guru" in this session. More than 70 research papers were published in National/international journals. One International conference and one International seminar proceeding were also published by the college in special issue of "Prabhandan Guru". 21 books/book chapter and more than 72 paper were published by the faculty members in various proceedings of National/International conferences and in edited books.

#### 11. Entrepreneurship Development and Innovation Centre

Shri Ram College has its own fully functional Intellectual Property Rights & Entrepreneurship Development cell (IPR&ED Cell) which supervises the Centre for Innovation which is working for all the students of Shri R'am Group of Colleges to promote innovative work. In this year the Centre ran projects and training for students. The College organized few seminars and webinars also this year. Due to the efforts of IQAC and Innovation Cell, many faculty members got 03 patent granted during the academic session.

#### 12. Academic Activities

The College conducted seven trainings programmes for teaching staff, four training programmes for non-teaching staff along with several FDPs for improving the skills of teaching and non-teaching staff. Twenty-Five Value Added/ Certificate Courses were running during the year for the students in various fields of study. Departments held academic events like seminars, workshop, guest lectures, quiz competitions, group discussions, debates and science exhibition etc. for the students. For teachers, different activities were held in almost all the departments including discussions on current and other relevant issues during this year under Saturday Tea Club meetings.

#### 13. International Relations and Other Collaboration

The College established collaborations as MoUs were signed between Shri Ram College and other organizations. MoUs which was going to expired, had been renewed. Workings with previously associated members was also continued and remained in progress as faculty exchange and student exchange programmes with IIMT Saharanpur and with CHSM Bulandshahr, S.D. (PG) College, Muzaffarnagar. 01 new MoU were signed in this year for cooperation in Agricultural Research, Education and Staff Student Exchange Program with Black Tulip Flowers, Black Tulip, Nairobi, Kenya. 07 guest lectures, 03 value added courses, 08 projects, many internship/training, faculty & student exchange programme and many social activities conducted under some collaborations/MoUs.

#### 14. Extra-Curricular Activities/ Extension Service

Shri Ram College, as its general policy, pays attention towards the overall development of students, during this session this aspect was kept in mind. Many industrial visits/ excursions/ cultural/academic tours were conducted in the session 2022-23 by different departments to improve learning of students. More than 32 extension activities including workshops were conducted by the NSS/Rover Ranger/ Cultural/Academic Committee of College and some of them were in collaboration with other institutes/ organizations. Annual Function of the college 'COLORS' was organized.

#### 15. Annual and Other Sports Tournaments

Annual Sports Meet was organized by the College where number of sports activities was conducted. The Affiliating University organized Inter-university sports competitions in which college secured individual positions in more than 38 games while more than 7 positions in team games. Students performed in various activities in many other universities with the support of the college faculty. List of students' achievements and participation is as follows:


