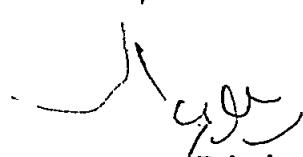

The seminar proved to be highly informative and impactful. It strengthened awareness regarding equality, inclusion, and social justice while motivating students and staff members to work

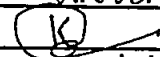
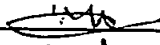
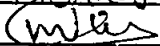
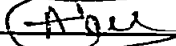
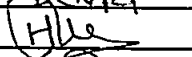
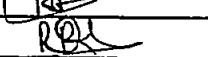
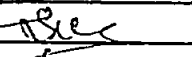
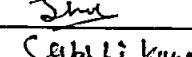
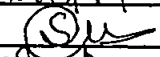
